

Dimer

"A dimer is an oligomer consisting of two monomers joined by bonds that can be either strong or weak, covalent or intermolecular".



The musicians unfold fluctuating spaces of sound by connecting static and structural material until it reveals a state of constant being. Electronic and acoustic impulses are intertwined into coherent patterns, which try to portray the distance between utter chaos and absolute harmony. The Duo Dimer was formed in 2016 during the collective study at the music university in Dresden. Today both musicians work as freelancers around Leipzig and are a part of the local music scene. They released their first album "Dimer" in March 2022 on the record label "Wabi-Sabi Tapes" from Lyon.

"The Leipzig duo Dimer is composed of Fabian Adams on saxophone and Jan-Einar Groh on drums. On their Debut-Album, each track is built from succinct elements. Whether it is melody, timbre or rhythm, each one is introduced with care and then blossoms in the long run. Halfway between the free ritornellos of Fire! and the hypnotic improvisations of Oren Ambarchi, the album is part of this free jazz movement that makes the listener lose his balance without abandoning him. From musical micro-events, Dimer builds a familiar base that once consolidated can be distorted, atomized and/or transcended."
